In 1980, Pope Saint John Paul II wrote, "...the Church and the world have great need of Eucharistic adoration. Jesus waits for us in this sacrament of love. Let us be generous with our time in going to meet Him in adoration and contemplation full of faith. And let us be ready to make reparation for the great faults and crimes of the world. May our adoration never cease."

- Prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff
- The faithful who on Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!)

Carlo, who died at age 15 of leukemia, was beatified on October 10, 2020, at Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, in Assisi, Italy. After completing it, he was struck with cancer and died in 2006 at the age of 16. This exhibition has been shown at the Vatican and dozens of countries around the world. The exhibit will be in St. Augustin Parish Center on Friday, April 19, for our school children and for all who wish to come. The Parish Center will be open Saturday, April 20, noon until after the 4:00 pm mass. And again on Sunday, April 21, before and after all Masses.
